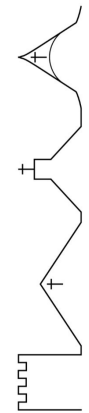
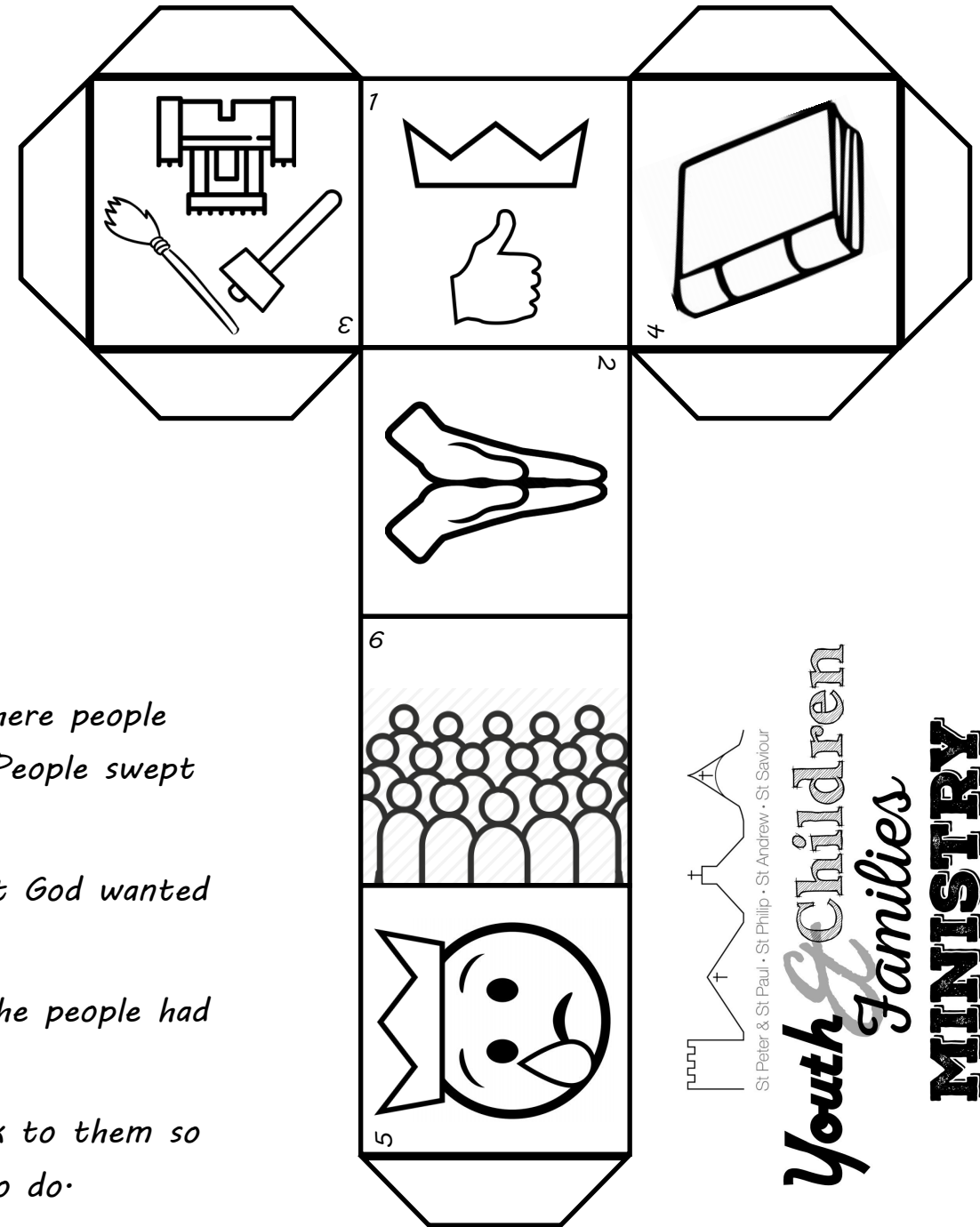


JOSIAH BECOMES KING - STORY CUBE

Have a go at trying to make a Story Cube for this week's story about King Josiah. Each square of the cube has a picture that tells a different part of the story. You can use the example here or have a go at making one with your own pictures.

Once you've made it, roll it and see if you can remember what part of the story the top face is telling. Why not see if you can memorise the whole story - maybe challenge your family to do it too!

1. King Josiah was a good king.
2. He taught the people to worship and pray to God.
3. King Josiah decided that the Temple, the building where people went to worship God, needed cleaning and mending. People swept and hammered. Then someone found an old book.
4. In the book were God's words and all the things that God wanted his people to do! What an important book!
5. When King Josiah read the book, he was very sad. The people had not been doing what God's words said they should.
6. So Josiah called everyone together. He read the book to them so that everyone would know what God wanted them to do.
