Indoor services

- continue to wear face coverings while in church
- be aware of spacing in all our churches, seating arrangements have been changed to something that resembles pre-COVID times
- please use the hand sanitiser and signing in sheets available

All of the above precautions are voluntary.

Holy Communion

Communion will continue to be administered in one kind under the form of bread alone.

We are asking worshippers to continue to share the Peace <u>without</u> physical contact.

THE PARISH OF ST PETER & ST PAUL TONBRIDGE Key points for those attending services (Updated 8th September 2021)

- SOCIAL DISTANCING is encouraged inside the church.
- WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS is encouraged inside the church unless exempt.
- Once in the foyer, CLEAN HANDS WITH SANITISER supplied
- Arrive in good time to be seated.
- For NHS Test & Trace either register the QR code on your phone <u>or</u> sign in using the consent form in the foyer for yourself and others in your "bubble".
- If using a pen supplied by the church, it should be placed in the box
 marked for used pens and <u>not</u> mixed with other pens
- Clean hands with sanitiser on leaving the church.
- A collection plate & card reader (P&P only) will be available at the end of the service for those wishing to donate.
- Toilets are available with extra cleaning sprays and hand washing facilities.
