

## **August 2025 Prayer Guide**

### **Monday prayer points: Scholars**

- Pray for Langham Scholar Davi Manco, who has returned to Brazil with his family after completing his studies. Pray that the Lord will give Davi much wisdom and guidance as he makes plans for future service.
- The Langham Scholars programme has strong links with various Bible colleges, associations and institutions around the world. Please pray for the Association for Christian Theological Education in Africa (ACTEA) led by Langham Graduate Dr David Tarus.
