Monday prayer points: Literature

- Give thanks for Colin Macpherson's many years supporting indigenous Christian publishing houses around the world. Pray that as Colin plans to retire in the near future that he would know the Lord's blessing and guidance.
- Pray for the impact of new Langham book 'Future Ready, Mission Faithful – Theological Education in Africa'. Pray that it'll be useful for educators, seminarians, church leaders and Christian development NGOs.
- A group is working (with Langham's support) to create a one-volume book on the history of Asian Christian leaders. Last month the editorial committee met together – please pray for this team, including Rico Villanueva and Joy Faraz.

- The International Selection Committee has its first review meeting this month, with some new members on board. Please pray for a smooth transition, and for the whole committee as they review and discuss the potential new Langham Scholars.

Wednesday prayer points: Preaching

- Pray for Dwi Handayani, Director of Langham Preaching in Asia & the South Pacific. Pray for stamina, focus and a close walk with the Lord.
- The need for more Langham Preaching resources in heart languages continues to increase. Pray for authors and translators to be encouraged in their skills so that our participants can fully access resources which enable them to learn and train others in the most effective way possible.
