

September 2026 Prayer Guide

Monday prayer points: Preaching

- Pray for 'facilitator' training workshops, which have been taking place recently in Lesotho (see photo above of a 2025 seminar). Pray for much fruit – that future preaching training in the country will improve as a result of these workshops.
- Praise God for Ico Matulić, Langham Preaching's coordinator for Croatia. He is a pastor for a church located on an island and is involved in missionary work on surrounding islands and on the mainland. Please pray for souls to be saved and for Ico as he mentors other preachers.
- Give thanks to God for preaching training which took place for 80 people at the end of last month in a sensitive MENA* country. Pray that these preachers would be strengthened in their ministry, encouraged to persevere and that they would remain united in purpose.
- Pray for Andy Oatridge, Langham Preaching's Director for Europe and the Caribbean. Pray for fresh insight and drive as a new academic year begins.

Tuesday prayer points: Literature

- Praise God for the Central Eastern European Bible Commentary (CEEBC), which was published in 2023, and includes over 100 articles addressing contemporary issues. Pray that the CEEBC will help pastors, preachers, teachers and lay leaders to apply biblical truths in their contexts.
- Pray for the impact of '*Confident in Conviction*', a recent Langham publication, written by a number of members of the Langham Preaching team from around the world. Pray that this book will help preachers to understand and deeply know the foundational truths of the bible, thinking about the "why" not just the "how" of writing sermons.
- Pray that God will give grace and help to Dr Hani Hanna, Director of the Langham Literature programme. Pray for wisdom in all his decision-making.
- Pray that the Lord will help Mark Arnold, Langham Literature's Editorial and Contracts Coordinator, in this vital role based at the Langham Service Centre in Carlisle.

Wednesday prayer points: Scholars

- We were moved during last month's Langham Live to hear Langham Scholar Oleksandr Geychenko's testimony of God's power and grace during the ongoing war in Ukraine. Please continue to pray for Oleksandr in his role as President of Odesa Theological Seminary.
- Give thanks for Gaynor Harvey, based in Scotland, who is Registrar for the Scholars programme. Pray that God would give Gaynor wisdom and focus in her work.
- Praise God for the ongoing impact of Langham Scholar Bayar Garamtseren's ministry in Mongolia, a closed country until the early 1990s. Pray for Bayar's work on the Mongolian

Standard Version of the Bible, to bring the Word of God to Mongolians in their own language.

- Remember the Langham Scholars team as they meet in the UK for their annual team meeting from 28 September to 2 October. Pray for safety in travelling, as well as wisdom and discernment in all the discussions that will take place during the week.

Thursday prayer points: UK and Ireland

- Pray that supporters across the UK will recognise the blessing of planning well for the future, and that Langham's partnership with Octopus Legacy of a free will-writing service will be a helpful tool for many as they consider leaving a Kingdom-shaping legacy through Langham.
- Give thanks to God for our volunteers, especially those who represented Langham at Summer conventions this year. Please pray for energy and enthusiasm as they "spread the word" about Langham in their churches and circles.
- Pray for LPUKI National Director John Libby, that God would grant him good health and strength in the coming months.

Friday prayer points: International

- Last month, devastating floods swept through Nepal and Tibet, causing mass devastation and killing many. Please pray for relief efforts, for comfort for God's people and for the hope of the Gospel to be shared.
- Please keep praying for just end to wars that are raging around the world, and especially for our Langham family who are serving the Lord in extremely difficult situations.
- Please pray for Langham's financial situation to improve so that the important work around the world will continue and expand.

Saturday & Sunday prayer points

- Please pray for our Autumn appeal, raising funds specifically for Langham's work in East Asia. Pray that many supporters, both longstanding and new, will be inspired to donate.
